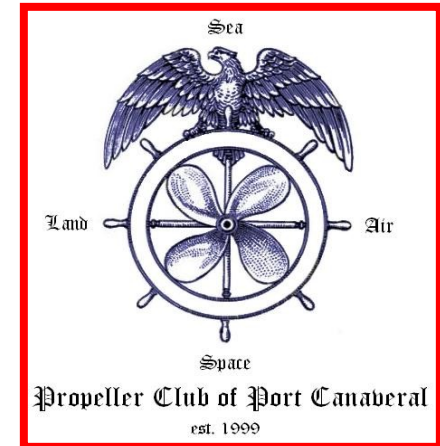
Annual dues are \$100. Those who become first-time members after March 30, shall pay prorated dues as follows:
