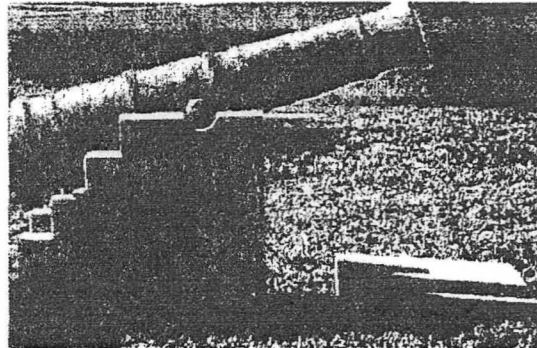


BREVARD'S SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF
